As luck would have it, Joan Dehm was alerted to the existence of this table by a friend from the Delaware County Historical Society who had recently been shopping at the store. After seeing it in person there was no doubt that the table belonged in the Historical Society's collection. "Of course, we had to have it," said Joan. The Society's board members voted to add this unique piece of furniture to our collection. As April pointed out the appeal of this table means so much more to people who are familiar with the township. April began hand painting Around Town tables in the 1980's. It started as a hobby and as fulfillment other than her job as a hairdresser. Her process of creating an "Around Town" table begins with locating an appropriate table that serves as a perfect backdrop for the scenery. Then she takes photos of the buildings she intends to hand paint on the table. Each chosen image is then lovingly recreated onto the surface. She admits that her chosen style is inspired by the Mackenzie-Childs' Courtly Checks pattern. The finished piece is a customized work of art.
